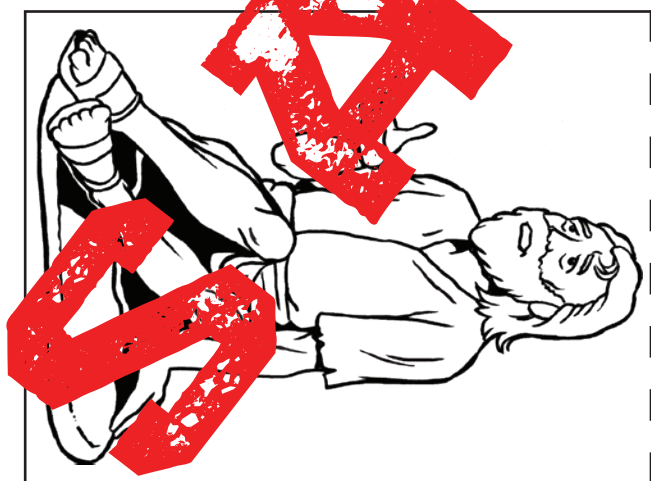




# JESUS MEETS A MAN BY THE POOL
